De-mything the GSA

•JAZZY JARS – twice a year we call on parents to create Jazzy Jars with their children, to donate to both summer fair and Christmas fair stalls. But what is a jazzy jar you ask? It's simply an old jar decorated by your kids and filled with any kind of wrapped sweets. To mark the occasion there is a dress down day at school.



•CAKE SALES – once a year each class is asked to hold a cake sale to raise money for the GSA. Children from that class are asked to bring in cakes to sell to the rest of the school. Don't feel pressured to bake, shop bought cakes are fine too. The sale is always on a Friday, straight after pick up. Cakes are 50p each, and the children are encouraged to man the stall along with some parent volunteers.



•FILM NIGHTS – we organise film nights for the children, where the school hall is turned into a cinema. Parent volunteers run the event, and during the half time interval a drink and snack is served.

To What Do I Have to Commit and Contribute in Order to be Part of the GSA?
