#### Welcome back

Happy New Year to you all and a warm welcome to our new families in Nursery. I do hope you all had a restful and healthy Christmas break.

#### **Snow**

It is that time of year again, where we have falling temperatures and snow is predicted. Can I please remind you that all children need a named warm winter coat. In the case of heavy snow we will endeavour to keep the school open with a reduced staff. Can I remind you that in the event of heavy snow, we will inform you if school is remaining open or closed via the text system, early in the morning, so you have time to make alternative arrangements. Also information will be posted on the school website. Once the County Council's Closure Notification System is informed of a school remaining open or being closed, parents can be informed via the radio stations, particularly Three Counties Radio.

#### **School Lunchtimes arrangements**

As some of you will be aware if you have a reception child at Greenway from January they are allowed to have school dinners every day. 68 reception children have chosen to have school dinners. To ensure that we do not have congestion in the dining room and that our youngest children have time to eat their dinner, we have reviewed our arrangements. Last week we trialled all children having their packed lunched in the hall, where children were sitting on the hall floor. The children thoroughly enjoyed this picnic experience, which we have carried out before due to kitchen closure and snow days. This allowed space to be freed up for all those children having a school dinner.

Following last week, our timings have become very slick and we are trialling KS2 children who have packed lunch sitting in the dining room as well. KS1 children will continue to sit in the hall around our picnic plastic tablecloths, which will be placed on the hall floor. We are continuing to monitor this situation.

#### Illness

Due to the high numbers of staff and pupils sickness at the end of last term, can I remind you to ensure that your child is fit and well when coming to school. We would all like a healthy term please!

If your child is going to be absent from school please notify the school office by 9.30am. A Request for Leave of Absence Form needs to be completed if you intend taking your child out of school for any reason other than sickness. These are available from the school office Please also let your child's teacher **and** the office know if your child has an appointment to attend.
