VIOLIN LESSONS AT GREENWAY SCHOOL FOR YEARS 1-4

Some of the pupils from Aldbury School came to give an assembly to our children today. Mrs Shenagh Franklin will visit the school on Friday mornings to take pupils for lessons and teaches the Suzuki method. Parental attendance in lessons is necessary because it is vital that what is taught in the lesson is practised at home during the week.

The cost of lessons is fixed by Hertfordshire Music Service:

Individual 20 minute lesson is £132 per term

Shared 30 minute lesson is £100 per term

Group lesson (3 or 4 children) is £66 per term. Shared and group lessons are, of course, subject to there being other pupils wishing to share a group.

Your child will need a violin and although there are a few violins for hire at school they may not be the right size for your child so you may need to rent or buy one. Mrs Franklin will be able to advise on this as it is often possible to buy outgrown ones from older pupils.

If your child wishes to learn to play it is important that s/he shows a real commitment and is willing to practice regularly.
