### **Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July - Sports Day**

Due to the recent weather conditions we would like to remind you that all children need to come to school with a water bottle, sun hat and sun screen applied for Sports Day.

The children will be taking their PE kits home before the 8<sup>th</sup> July and they will need **to come to school wearing them on Wednesday morning**. They do **not** need to bring in a book bag or their school clothes.

#### **Sports Day Morning**

The morning will start at approximately 9:30am and consists of 16 different activities which the children will move between in their house groups. If you plan to cheer on your child please move onto the large field after drop off to await the start. Please do not allow siblings to play with the sports equipment before drop off or whilst waiting! The morning events will last approximately 2 hours. After the carousel of activities we will be holding a mums and dads race. It will be a 100 metre race, if you wish to participate please come wearing the appropriate clothing and footwear, **NO RUNNING SPIKES!!!**

#### **Sports Day Afternoon**

The competitive afternoon will start at approximately 1:30pm. If you have been watching in the morning you will need to leave the school site and return for the afternoon session, so that the playground and field is cleared ready for lunchtime.

#### **Running events:**

Children have been placed into heats and the first two or three from each heat (depending on the number of heats) will go through to a final. Key Stage 2 will run 50 metre obstacle course and 100 metres, with Key Stage 1 running 50 metre obstacle course.

#### **Throwing events:**

Children will throw in their year group. Key Stage 1 children will throw the foam javelins and Key stage 2 will throw the turbo javelins.

Year 3, 4 and 5 will be competing on the large playground and Year 1 and 2 will be competing on the field by the adventure trail.

All events are same sex events with children from the same year group.
