Feedback on the Parent/Carer & Pupil Questionnaires 2016

Thank you to all those parents, carers and children who completed a copy of our online survey earlier this year, and particularly to those parents and carers who additionally completed Ofsted's Parent View survey. Please note that once registered with Parent View, you can update the survey (for any school where you have a child) at any time and that each response you give only lasts for that academic year, so if you want to have your say, you will need to provide at least one response each school year.

Each year, Greenway's Governing Body chooses to seek your confidential and voluntary feedback across a range of questions and statements to make sure that we are focussing our attention, in supporting the school, on issues that matter to you.

What feedback did you give?

Attached here are Summary reports, one for Parents/Carers' findings and a separate one for Pupils' findings.

These reports have been prepared following detailed consideration by the Head, SLT (Senior Leadership Team) and Governing Body of all of the matters you raised and the comments you made. Copies of these summary reports are also on the school website, along with the full reports which show detailed data breakdown by year group and key findings question by question.

We hope that you will be as delighted with and interested by the results as we have been. While we will share findings with pupils in school, we hope that you might also find time to discuss the contents of these reports with your children at home.

What Does School and the Governing Body do with this feedback?

Feedback is used as both a monitoring tool for the current School Plan, as well as a mechanism by which parent/carers and pupil 'voice' can be included in the school's planning process moving forward. The school's SLT and Governing Body have therefore reviewed the reports and discussed recommendations in the context of school planning for next year.

The School Plan for 2016/17 will be finalised at a Governing Body Strategy Meeting early in September and a summary will appear on the school website under the Ofsted tab in the Autumn Term. The Governing Body will then monitor the school's performance against this plan, with minutes of all Governing Body meetings available from the school's office on request.
