**PEOPLE NOT BORDERS** Berkhamsted are collecting for children in hospital in Aleppo and adults at the Dunkirk refugee camp. We would like to help. Can you support us by contributing towards the following?:

28th November - 2nd December

We need items for:

**BAGS OF LOVE APPEAL FOR CHILDREN IN HOSPITAL, ALEPPO** (UK Action for Refugees)

These have been requested by the doctors providing medical aid in Aleppo. It's just like a shoebox appeal, but involving a drawstring/duffle bag that we will provide. Ideally we would like each bag to include:

1. A cuddly toy, no bigger than 10" – this doesn't have to be new as long as it is clean and undamaged
2. A pack of felt tips or pencil crayons (with a sharpener) and a pad/notebook
3. An outdoor toy such as a tennis ball, skipping rope, yoyo etc
4. A packet of sweets - HALAL suitable - please make sure they have no gelatine in them.
5. A picture drawn by the child who has filled it, or a photo, and/or a note telling those children that we care.

**CARE PACKS FOR ADULTS IN DUNKIRK** (refugee camp)

We will make these up and take them out ourselves before Christmas. We are asking for:

**MEN:** underpants, socks, hat, gloves, scarf, toothbrush and toothpaste, hand sanitiser/wipes, razor and foam, brush, comb, wind-up torch, notebook and pen.

**WOMEN:** knickers, socks, hat, gloves, scarf, toothbrush and toothpaste, hand sanitiser/wipes, sanitary towels, brush, comb, wind-up torch, notebook and pen.

Just one item from each list would be good, but if you can bring everything on the list in a bag we will transfer the items into a waterproof bag that will in itself be essential.

Don't worry if you don't have time to find all the items, just bring what you can. If you have a spare, small clean soft toy at home, bring them along with your picture/photo and lots of love: You can buy additional items to fill your bags at the gazebo.

We will also be accepting cash donations which we will use to make up any incomplete bags and go towards the cost of the bags themselves.
