

Following several complaints from residents of Crossways please adhere to the following procedures

Travelling to School ADVICE FOR NEW PARENTS

Greenway School is committed to ensuring that everyone travelling to school can do so as safely as possible. With this in mind, parents and children are encouraged to walk to school.

Walking to school keeps the children fit, encourages social interaction and reduces congestion around the school gates. The school is situated in a residential area and there is very little parking available on neighbouring streets.

There are 3 ways to access the school site:

- through the Greenway School entrance on Crossways;
- through the St Thomas More School entrance on Greenway;
- via the alleyway off Gilbert Way / Shootersway.

Please note that all these access points are intended to be used as pedestrian-only entrances into school. For the children's safety, **parents** are not permitted to drive their cars into the school grounds.

If you *have* to drive to school please drive slowly on the roads approaching the school gates. If you drive and park in Crossways please adhere to the informal parking system we have in operation. This requires you to drive down towards the school, turn around in the turning circle and then park on the other side facing towards Shootersway. Please do not turn around in resident's driveways. Please park considerately for our neighbours.

Please do not park in the turning circle or on the yellow School Keep Clear Lines or on the raised part of the road near the junction with Shootersway. The Police do enforce these restrictions.
