**Emergency inhaler for use in school.**

The Governing Body of Greenway School has recently agreed its policy on Supporting Pupils with Medical Conditions. As part of that policy, the school has chosen to hold an emergency salbutamol inhaler and spacer for use by pupils who have been prescribed a reliever inhaler and for whom written parental consent for its use has been obtained.

The use, storage, care and disposal of the inhaler and spacers will follow the school’s policy on supporting pupils with medical conditions.

The school holds a register of children prescribed an inhaler and this list is kept with the emergency inhaler.

Parents/carers will be informed if their child has used the emergency inhaler.
