#### Late Arrivals

Can I please remind you that children who arrive late at school in the morning must be brought to the front entrance and marked in by the office staff. Nursery children start at 9.00am, Reception and KS1 start at 8.55am and KS2 at 8.50am.

#### Absence and Sickness

If your child is going to be absent from school please notify the school office by 9.30am and if they attend Waccy inform the staff on the Waccy number: 07708 572459.

A 'Request for Leave of Absence' form must be completed if you intend to take your child out of school for any reason other than sickness. These are available from the school office. Please also let your child's teacher **and** the office know if your child has an appointment to attend.

#### Uniform – please label everything

Please can I remind you that all children except those in Nursery need wear a Greenway school jumper or cardigan, grey shorts, trousers, skirt or pinafore and a white or green polo shirt. All children must have indoor shoes which can be black plimsolls/trainers BUT NOT slippers as these do not support your child's feet. Socks and tights need to be black or grey. ALL children need a warm, waterproof coat. Children also need to have their hair tied back with appropriate dark coloured clips and simple bands.

#### Rucksacks

You may remember that sample Greenway branded rucksacks for KS1 and KS2 were available for you to see at our open evening in July. These are now available to buy from the school office. Prices are: KS1 rucksack - £7.70, KS2 rucksack £10.20. We look forward to seeing the children using these to bring their belongings to school.
