School uniform

It has been lovely to see all your children looking so smart this week. Please can I remind you that all children, except those in Nursery, need to wear a Greenway school jumper or cardigan, grey shorts, trousers, skirt or pinafore, a white or green polo shirt and black school shoes. All children must have indoor shoes which can be black plimsolls/trainers BUT NOT slippers. Long hair should be tied back with appropriate dark coloured clips and simple bands. Please label all items of school uniform with your child's name. This will help us to avoid the mountain of lost property that accumulated during the course of last year!

Packed lunches and snacks

Greenway promotes healthy eating and is keen to see this reflected in the packed lunches and snacks brought in from home. Please do not give your children sandwiches filled with peanut butter, or any other foods containing nuts, as we have a number of children with severe nut allergies in school.
