We are holding a sharing best practice event. This will involve listening to ideas from Mary McCrystal, Autism Lead Roman Fields school, an introduction to Louise Howe, Specialist Advisory Teacher and hearing the support that the outreach teams, Woodfield (Beverley Hamilton) and St Luke's School (Rachel Andrew) can provide.

In addition we are asking parents and teachers to speak for approx. 10 minutes to share an idea that school has implemented that has supported a young person with Autism.

The categories will follow the AET standards (Autism Education Trust) www.autismeducationtrust.org.uk of:

The individual Pupil – for example, sharing information about a young person, managing and preventing bullying, recognising the needs of a young person and responding appropriately e.g. stress, anxiety, consulting with children etc

Building Relationships - for example building relationships with parents and young people and teachers, how the Lead role has been developed and the benefit of this. Supporting young people to develop relationships within school etc

Curriculum and learning- for example adaptations in planning lessons, using visual supports, how schools share pupil profiles in secondary schools, assess learning and flexibility in learning etc

Enabling environments for example sensory profiles, how young people are supported in unstructured times, calm rooms, Ideas to support transitions etc
