£5,170	Counselling	Identified children have 1:1 counselling session weekly with qualified counsellor.	Increased resilience, self-esteem and improved attitudes to learning, enhanced social communication and peer relationships.
£1,676.61	Miscellaneous curriculum issues	Financial support is provided for basic needs e.g. travel to/from school; school equipment and for enrichment activities e.g. school trips; swimming and musical instrument lessons.	Children are able to take part in all curriculum activities.
£738	Clubs	Financial support is provided for after school clubs e.g. Ross and Andy's soccer club; Superkids; Mad Science; WACCY.	Children have access to the full range of after school activities and families are supported through free after-school childcare.
£28,068	Learning support (staffing)	<p>A range of interventions eg. social skills, friendships groups are delivered by teaching assistants to support the learning needs of the children.</p> <p>A teacher is employed to run 'Literacy Intervention' sessions with identified children.</p> <p>Teaching assistants meet identified children's social, emotional and behavioural needs through a range of support e.g. meet and greet, liaising with parents/carers and 1:1 support.</p> <p>Nurture group is accessible for all children every lunchtime and is supported by teachers.</p>	<p>Progress in core subjects is accelerated through targeted adult support in lessons and some intervention groups.</p> <p>Progress in Reading and Writing is accelerated through frequent, intensive sessions with qualified specialist teacher. Staff have been coached in specific literacy strategies which has continued in the classroom environment.</p> <p>Attitudes to learning, self-esteem and strategies for managing emotions are all improved so that children are able to access all areas of school life. Nurture group has enabled children to access a calm play space, which is supported by teachers to enhance social skills and self –esteem.</p>
