
Greenway Parent/Carer Survey 2013/14

That's an amazing 74% return rate, which OFSTED would call 'a large majority'. Because so many of you had your say, we can be very confident that the findings are representative of the views of families at Greenway.



Our Response: Greenway has taken innovative steps with marking over the last 3 years and so Governors are pleased to see yet another year-on-year increase in positive data from parents/carers. Our Response: School curriculum mornings/evenings on Read Write Inc, Maths and Big Write have been well attended and positively praised. Information from those sessions is now also on the website. Further curriculum sessions are planned for next year and we will continue to support school in making these as accessible as possible, so that even more parents/carers feel able to support their children's learning at home.

Our Response: While continuing to draw a positive response from a very large majority of parents/carers, we acknowledge that this question also drew the largest negative response (12.1% or 29 parents/carers) in the survey. However, the report to Governors on feedback from last year's annual (end of year) Pupil Progress Reports identified a significant amount of praise for the 'comprehensive', 'constructive', 'informative' and 'individually tailored' content, with some parents/carers even expressing concern that reports were 'too long' and creating 'too great a workload' for teachers. From that, we must assume that any issues being expressed here relate to more routine communication that is received about children's progress. A review of the Pupil Progress Reports has already been scheduled to take on-board last year's feedback and to review them against other Primary School reports in Berkhamsted. We will also ensure that 2-way communication continues to be encouraged, to find ways in which school can improve performance even further in this area.

Our Response: We are pleased to note the overall positive response here, and will continue to support school in working to provide timely and comprehensive information to parents/carers. In particular, Greenway has made significant progress with regularly updating the website with news and photographs, and is developing the School Newsletter so that it routinely covers news on key themes (like sports). We will also continue to work with school on targeting texts and emails, but note that opinion on whether these are appropriate now (in terms of too many or too few) is entirely divided.



Our Response: We believe that, through Greenway's transition programme, this school is particularly good at supporting children in the next steps of their education. It is therefore pleasing to note that most of you agree. School will continue to support children in this way, while seeking to engage with the very small (but notable) minority of parents/carers who said that they did not know how or whether this happened.



What parents/carers thought Greenway did particularly well or what you like most about the school... A total of 178 parents/carers left unprompted detailed comments. Many covered more than one theme. You can see the top themes (those with 25 or more comments) on the chart above.

Things that parents/carers think we could improve upon at Greenway... A total of 163 parents/carers left unprompted detailed comments here. Most of these covered single issues only. Every theme has been reviewed by the Governing Body, including the Head and Deputy Head. The two themes which were mentioned 25 times or more are shown on the chart above.

Top Comments

Teaching staff – including quality, pitch, stretch, welcome, enthusiasm, approachability and professionalism from teachers and TAs – Teaching staff was by far the most popular theme and the subject of 115 positive comments from parents/carers.

Pastoral care – including kindness, nurturing and one-on-one or whole family support from teachers, TAs, the Head and Deputy Head – Pastoral care was specifically mentioned in over forty percent of positive comments left by parents/carers.

Sport – 62 comments asked for more of, and higher quality, sports/games in lessons, plus more clubs (before/after school and at lunchtime), and team/inter-school and competitive sport.

Standard of Education – 61 comments praised the standard of education including the level of expectation, engaging themes, well structured days, fun lessons, extra support, plus specific mentions for quality maths and literacy/phonics lessons.

Our Response – We are very grateful for the overwhelming number of positive comments about Greenway, which we have shared with staff. To see what we have already achieved and plan further specifically for sport, please see the separate Sport Survey report (on the website). We already do more sport than ever and sport is now included in the School Development Plan for 2014/15 with objectives to increase challenge and skills development for an even higher proportion of pupils.
