Berkhamsted Reorganisation – Travel to and from Schools

You will have seen the letter dated 12 June sent to all parents within the Town relating to “Berkhamsted Education Changes – Travel Choices”.

The school is in discussion with the Safer Routes to School Team at Hertfordshire County Council about the specific issues affecting travel to and from Greenway. However, as a Governing Body involved in the reorganisation of education provision within the Town we wish to see that all children within the Town are able to travel to and from school safely.

Governors have written a response to the Safer Routes to School team setting out concerns that there is insufficient provision in place for September 2013 at some key “hot spots”.

It may well be that you have children who will be transferring to other schools within the Town in September 2013. Should you have concerns as to their future journeys to and from school we would urge that you write expressing your worries to both Safer Routes to School and the Town Council:
