- Please label all belongings.
- Please have a spare set of uniform.
- Please tie up all long hair, (boys and girls).
- Please keep children at home for 48 hours after they were last sick.

- Milk Order with the office. Free to 3 & 4 year olds.
- Allergies please keep us updated if there are any changes to your child's medical needs.

Communication

Please write a note for:

- Informing the school of appointments or communicating any issues that arise.
- Please speak to the class teacher or write a note to arrange a meeting about your child.
- It is very important that you let us know of anything that may affect your child in school. If you should have any situations that arise that could affect the emotion of your child please also inform us. E.g. moving house, illness of close relatives, parent travelling and being away from home.

Home learning

- There are no formal home learning tasks for children in Nursery.
 We would suggest that you:-
- Share story books with your child as often as possible.
- Use money when visiting the shop, weigh items when making cakes and find many practical ways of involving maths in daily life.
- Play games involving taking turns, using dice and counting.
- Please ensure writing is in lower case, where appropriate.
- Some home learning activities are sent home in the holidays, but these are not 'homework'.
