Children's Mobile Phones

- If your child is going to walk home unaccompanied and you wish them to carry a mobile phone, they may bring them to school.
- These phones must be turned off and handed to the teacher as soon as the child is in school.
- The child's phone must be clearly labelled with their name.
- Please make sure that your child understands that this phone should only be used when necessary; they should not be walking home with them 'on display'.
- A letter will be going out about walking to school independently and mobile phones.

Communication

Please write a note or send an email for:

- Informing the school of appointments
- Please speak to the class teacher or write a note to arrange a meeting about your child
- It is very important that you let us know of anything that may affect your child in school. If you should have any situations that arise that could affect the emotion of your child please also inform us. E.g. moving house, illness of close relatives, parent travelling and being away from home.

Home learning

- Literacy homework will be given out on Friday to be completed and handed in the following Wednesday. Or children will be given a longer period of time to complete project work linked to our themes.
- Maths homework will be given out on Wednesday to be completed and handed in the following Monday.
- If homework is not completed and handed in on time the consequence it will be completed during play time, lunch time and Golden Time (this is on advice from past students!).

Home Learning Spellings

- Spellings will be given out every two weeks on Monday. Your child will need to write the words into sentences. Please focus on handwriting, punctuation and demonstration of understanding. They will have two weeks to complete this and they will hand it in on the Friday but not before, as you are expected to practise them.
- There will be a dictation every two weeks including words using the same spelling rule.
- The whole class will learn the same spelling rule, learning the rule and referring to it throughout the two weeks.
- This is to ensure that spellings are applied in writing rather than just learning them for a test.

Reading

- Your child will have a reading record for us to communicate in about their reading.
- Your child will be part of a guided reading session once a week and we may offer ideas on what to focus on next.
 This will be indicated in the reading record with GR
- Your child will need to practise reading to an adult regularly. Please acknowledge this by signing the reading record at least once a week.
- Your child will need to write in their reading record at least 3 times a week or they will lose Golden Time (on advice from our ex-pupils)

Maths

- You can help your child at home by viewing our calculation policy which is on our website.
- You can also play games with your child involving Maths, such as snakes and ladders and Monopoly.
- You can use money when visiting the shop, weigh items when making cakes and find many practical ways of involving Maths in daily life.
- Times tables and the inverse operation are essential so please practise frequently.
- Please use Mathletics at home and tasks will occasional be set for homework.

Marking

- Your child's work will be marked using a green pen and pink and green highlighters. Positive aspects are underlined in pink; areas for growth in green. They will often be given a next step to improve.
- The children will be given the opportunity to read and reflect on their marked work.
- They will be rewarded for excellent work through house points and stars. Special Awards will also be given by Mrs Ellwood in recognition of outstanding effort and achievement. Exceptional achievements will result in a postcard home.
