

KS1 RECORDER CLUB

Dear Parents.

In KS1 we offer a weekly recorder club for children in Y1 and Y2. The club meets every FRIDAY lunchtime from 12.15-12.45. The children will need to eat their lunch before the club starts, and those children who are in recorder club will get to go into lunch first, and will not have to queue. The staff on duty at lunchtime will always allow the children through.

Places at the club are limited to a maximum of 15, and if you wish your child to join, please fill out the reply slip below. The children will need to have their own recorder in school every Monday, as we do not have spare recorders to share out. The class teachers will remind them just before lunch. However, in the unlikely event your child forgets to come, it may be difficult for me to locate them once the club has started. If this happens, we will let you know if your child has missed 2 consecutive sessions, so you can have a chat with them at home about it.

Cost for the club, will be worked out once we know numbers, however it is usually around $\pounds 15-\pounds 20$ per term. Your child will remain in the club, unless you let us know in writing that you wish them to stop. During the year, the children will have 3 opportunities to perform at the end of each term. This may be a special assembly, or evening concert.

Recorder club will start on Monday 17^{th} September, and please assume your place is confirmed, unless we let you know otherwise.

We look forward to welcoming your child to recorder club, and the start of their musical journey at school.
