- Through half termly Pupil Progress meetings with the head and INCO Ms Roe and the class teacher's discuss every child
- Targets are set, progress scrutinised and impact discussed
- As a result of these meetings new interventions are put in place, staff can be re-deployed, extra strategies put in place, discussions with parents, children move groups, pupil interviews
