Many children in Years 5 and 6 are now successfully walking to and from school without supervision. Please can we remind parents of children in Year 4 who are keen to start walking independently that it has always been our policy to prepare the children by delivering Pedestrian Skills training in the Summer of Year 4. If you would like your Year 4 child to walk to and from school unsupervised before then, please ask the office for a permission slip, as your child's teacher needs to know that you have given your written consent for them to leave the classroom alone at the end of the day.

Packed lunches and snacks – PLEASE READ!

Greenway promotes healthy eating and is keen to see this reflected in the packed lunches and snacks brought in from home. A couple of reminders about snacks: firstly, snacks in Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 are provided free of charge, so there is no need for children in these classes to bring a snack into school. Secondly, children in Key Stage 2 should bring in snacks that match those enjoyed by the younger children i.e. fresh fruit/vegetables, a small quantity of dried fruit or – for those who need a bit more energy – a simple carbohydrate such as bread sticks or plain rice cakes. We have recently noticed some children with cereal bars, which are high in sugar and often contain nuts. **Please do not send these into school as we have several children with severe nut allergies who are at risk if exposed to the slightest trace of nuts.**
