Re: Maths Curriculum Evening - 14.11.18.

We will be holding a Maths Curriculum Evening on **Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> November from 7.30-9.00pm**. The evening will be led by David Cook who is the Lead Primary Teaching and Learning Adviser (mathematics) for Hertfordshire for learning.

If you have previously attended a Maths evening at Greenway, you will be familiar with the methods of written calculation we teach and these are described in our 'Written Calculations Policy' available on the school website. This event will give you an insight into the way Maths teaching at Greenway has evolved since the introduction of the new national curriculum and the planning material that we follow.

The evening will cover:

- the explicit teaching of strategies
- use of concrete and pictorial models that really help pupils understand
- the focus upon language to explain and reason (more mathematical talk in the classroom) and that includes thinking as mathematicians to make efficient strategy choices;
- ways that challenge is offered (and not bigger numbers!).

There will be practical activities and mini-teaching sessions from all Key Stages. I am sure you will find it interesting, informative and fun and we would love to see as many of you as possible there. To give us an indication of numbers, please return the slip below if you are intending to come.
