Guidance for Greenway Camping 2019

Please follow this guidance to keep us all safe and ensure the event is a success!

Preparation, Checklist and Do's and Don'ts

Please DO:

- Remember it can get cold in the evening/night so bring extra layers and winter coats/hats especially when it's a hot day.
- Remember sleeping bags, airbeds and pumps. Plus a mallet to hammer in tent pegs.
- Bio-degradable cutlery and plates will be provided, however please bring your own cups so we can reduce waste.
- Bring drinking water for your family.
- Bring plenty of cash for the bar & children's tuck shop (no credit cards)
- Bring entertainment for your children for between the dawn chorus and 7am!
- Feel free to bring outdoor games for the daytime.
- Bring torches there are no lights or electricity.
- Bring something to sit on chair/picnic blanket.
- Bring anti-bacterial hand gel.

Please DON'T:

- Bring any glassware and bottles on site.
- Bring bikes or scooters.
- Bring pets.
- Bring cookers, generators, gas appliances, candles or any other naked flames.
- Smoke the school operates a no smoking policy on all areas of the school grounds.
- Bring any alcohol on site. There will be a pay bar including soft drinks and we are reducing bar prices this year. Please respect this rule as the bar is the way the event raises money for the school and the children.
- Bring nuts we have some folks with serious nut allergies.

Coming and Going

- Campers will be coming in through both Crossways gates and the Thomas More entrance
- You will be allocated a 15 minute arrival slot by email. Please arrive during your allocated slot/entrance, to ease congestion.
- On arrival we'll give you bin bags: please use these for your rubbish/recycling and take them home with you. There will be no access to the school bins during the event.
- The gates will be locked at 3:45pm to prevent traffic flow through the site and to keep children from straying (the combination code for the padlocks is **1442**).
- If you enter through Crossways please drop off tents, bags and kit in the parking bays on the right as you come through the gates, then park in the playground outside Green Ash/Red Ash after unloading. Overflow parking will be on the main playground. Please move cars from the parking bays ASAP – this is an unloading area only.
- If you enter through Thomas More entrance you can drive up and park on their playground and unload from there.
- Please don't drive on the grass.
- So we can contact you if needed (eg, car alarms, obstructions), please leave your mobile number visible in your car.
- Please leave the site by 10am and ensure you leave the site as you found it.

Setting up

- Please camp on the large field on the right of the Crossways drive.
- Please camp a **minimum of three metres** from any other tent (as measured from the closest point of the fabric of the tent, including any awning or other structure).

- Anyone pitching an older canvas type tent should ensure the separation distance around such a tent should be four metres.
- Please don't leave valuable items in the tents the site has three entrances and is not secure.

Amenities

- Toilets and wash basins will be accessible in the school buildings. All children should be supervised when going to the toilets.
- There is no access to the School Buildings apart from this. Any unauthorised entry to the school will set off the alarm system.
- Night time 'quiet' is from **10pm until 7am**. We've communicated this to local residents so please respect this.

Food and Drink

- Food will be served in sittings: please check your email to find out which you've been assigned to so we can keep the queues down we'll also put up a list on the day in case you can't remember.
- Breakfast is included in the price of your entry ticket.

Safety and Security

- Please make yourselves aware of the location of fire fighting and first aid equipment on arrival (see below).
- A campfire (by way of firepits) will run from 7pm. This will be cordoned off and staffed at all times. It's vital that everyone respects the cordon and authority of the person in charge.
- Children are not permitted on Thomas More's playing field or play equipment.
- Greenway's adventure playground will be out of bounds from 8pm.
- Parents/carers are responsible for children in their party at all times and are asked to remind them to respect the school grounds and be aware of the homes adjacent to the school.

Emergencies

- The assembly point in the event of a fire is by the undercover picnic benches alongside the main playground.
- First aid kit will be available outside the staff room.
