MATHS Count in 2's	Go to your sock drawer (ask an adult first) Take out pairs of socks. A pair is 2 socks. If they are folded, unfold them and lay them on the floor in 2's. Have 3 pairs to begin with.  Hold your fingers then count each sock whilst they are laying in pairs. Count in one's first, 1,2 4,4 5,6 Next time count again but in 2's 2, 4, 6 Did you find it quicker to count this way?	Two days: Mon & Tues.  How many groups of 2 do you have? That's right, 3. You have 2 groups of 2. How many socks altogether? Yes! You have 6 socks altogether. ADULTS: You could also say you have 3 times 2, but don't rush into times tables, children need to fully understand what groups look like and not simply recite tables. They need to be able to show what it looks like with objects.  Add more socks and count in ones again then in 2's. Be confident counting in 2's to 10 then to challenge yourself to 20.
