

Phonics Tasks

This week you are going to be following the sounds and instructions on the PowerPoint. We are revising the first vowel sounds and then the longer (split) vowel sounds. Each day you will read the sound, repeat the sound 3 times out loud. Draw the sound in the air with your finger, draw it on the table with your fringer, or on an adult's back (like we do in school with our partners sometimes!) Then use the words on the following page of the PowerPoint that match the sound of the day. Sound and blend the words. Write the words in sentences. Can you think of any more words with that sound?

Use the phoneme spotters in resources to then read a text with the sound of the day in. Colour in the word with the sound (we have done this before)
