

Week beginning 29th June 2020

English learning for 2 weeks

Monday 29th June:

Today you will be making predictions from the front-cover and listen to a reading of Peter and the Wolf. You will be revising and practising speech punctuation and write sentences to summarise the story.

Open the pdf labelled Activities 29th June and use the PowerPoint labelled Dialogue with audio.

Tuesday 30th June:

Today you will be looking at an illustration and listening to the musical extract that matches it. Your activity today will be to imagine some speech and then write a paragraph. The revision sheets included in the pdf will support you in this activity.

Open the pdf labelled Activities 30th June to access today's learning.

Wednesday 1st July:

Today you will be looking at another illustration and listen to the accompanying music. Your task today is to imagine a new ending to the story and write this, including direct speech.

Open the pdf labelled Activities 1st July to find the illustration and instructions for today. There are questions for you to answer, that will support you in thinking about an alternative ending.

Thursday 2nd July:

Today you will read a poem and use picture prompts to learn it by heart. You will also revise poetry vocabulary such as rhythm, rhyme and alliteration.

You will now read three more poems and practise performing one of these.

The last activity is to copy your favourite poem using your neatest handwriting.

Open the pdf labelled Activities 2nd July.

Friday 3rd July:

The last activity for the week is for you to read another poem and make your own picture prompts to help you learn it by heart. You will also be investigating word classes in a poem and then write your own poem with a similar structure.

Open the pdf labelled Activities 3rd July to complete these activities.

Monday 6th July:

Today you will be making predictions about The Night Shimmy. You will need to listen to the story and then answer questions about its artwork.

Open the pdf labelled Activities 6th July to complete these activities.

Tuesday 7th July:

For your learning today you will be listening to Silly Billy. The activities will require you to re-write a set of instructions and then write a letter about your own worries.

Open the pdf labelled Activities 7th July to complete these activities.

Wednesday 8th July:

Today you will need to listen to both stories again and answer comparison questions. The main activity today will be to describe and illustrate your own magical object.

Open the pdf labelled Activities 8th July to complete these activities.

Thursday 9th July:

You will be listening to Voices in the Park today. You will need to read the text and answer questions. The main activity is for you to write a version of the day from the point of view of one of the dogs.

Open the pdf labelled Activities 9th July to complete these activities.

Friday 10th July:

For the last day of the week, you will need to listen to Voice in the Park again. You will need to divide some of the text into paragraphs. This will support you in using paragraphs. I would like you to imagine the next day at the park and write about it from the point of view of one of the characters. You are creating as sequel.
