

GREENWAY SCHOOL COOKBOOK

RECIPE AND PHOTO GUIDELINES

If you wish to submit a recipe for the Greenway School Cookbook please follow these hints and tips. We have provided a template to use if you wish, alternatively please create your own with the same sections, as explained below.

Please email your entry to the GSA by **Friday 11th September** to gsa@greenway.herts.sch.uk, attaching a photo or drawing of your creation, if you wish.

Sections:

- 1. Recipe Name, Childs Name and Class**
- 2. Ingredients** - Please list all the ingredients using spoon or metric measurements e.g.200g flour or 1 tsp of baking powder
- 3. Preparation/Cooking Time and Temperature** – Please state the cooking temperature (Celcius) and length of time for cooking or preparation.
- 4. Description** – this is where you can add a little comment if you wish eg why did you chose it? why do you like it? how would you serve it? or a tip on how to make it more yummy.
- 5. Instructions** - use numbered steps to describe how to make it including what equipment to use. Keep it as simple as possible!

Please note: we may not be able to publish every child's recipe in full. For example, if there are duplicates we may amalgamate entries but will reference each child's name.

Photo Guidelines:

If you wish to attach a photo with your recipe please adhere to the following guidelines. Photos are optional. Alternatively, please send us a drawing!

- Attach one photo either of the creation on its own, or of the child holding it.
- Only your own child(ren) from Greenway to be shown.
- Use a plain background and good lighting.
- The creation/child should take up 75% of the photo – ie close up not at a distance.
- Landscape or Portrait orientation is OK.
- Please use as high resolution/image size as possible.

Please note: we will only be able to include a selection of the photos and drawings submitted. For the photos which are selected, parents/guardians will be contacted separately to provide email consent for the photos to the published.

We hope you have fun doing this activity over the summer and are excited about seeing your creation and maybe your face published in our very own Greenway School Cookbook!
