If you would like your child to take part in the event, please e-mail your school office directly to confirm your place. Please also let them know if you will not be able to make the event, so we can be clear everyone has replied to the concert invitation. In order to take part in the event you <u>MUST</u> be able to attend all the dates above. The joint rehearsal is a really important time for the choirs to come together and gain their confidence ahead of the big day, as well as finalise placings etc....
