Year 2 Roald Dahl Museum Trip- Great Gaddesden

Throughout the year, your children have shown a real love of Roald Dahl's stories during our class reads. We have used Roald Dahl's writing edits to develop as writers and he has inspired us to use exciting vocabulary. On **Thursday 6th June**, your children will continue to develop their English skills as they will be going to Roald Dahl's museum.

Children should wear school uniform and bring a suitable outdoor coat. **Everyone** will need their school rucksack with their packed lunch inside AND a separate snack with a named drink. Water bottles need to be named.

To keep all children on the trip safe, <u>please check all ingredients</u> in your child's packed lunch. The following foods **are not** allowed on the trip:

- glass bottles
- all nuts
- sesame (including hummus)
- egg (all forms... no cake)
- celery
- leek
- avocado
- pesto
- fizzy drinks
- sweets
- chocolate

All items need to be in their rucksack.

The GSA have kindly funded our coach and so the cost for this visit is **£16.60** per child, which includes a goody bag.

As always, this amount will be a voluntary contribution but if we do not receive sufficient support then the visit cannot take place. We would like all pupils to take part in this visit but if you have any problems with this please contact Mrs Ellwood as soon as possible. If you hold a Dacorum discount card or if you are eligible for Pupil Premium then the voluntary contribution is reduced to **£3.32**.

For your child to be able to attend, we require payment via Arbor by **Friday 17 May**. To make payment please log into your Arbor account, select the 'trips' option. Consent will automatically be given.

We expect to be back at school by 3:15pm but you will be informed if there is a delay due to traffic conditions.
