Dear Parents/carers

Year 1 Educational Visit – Friday 7 June

On Friday 7 June, we have arranged for Year 1 to visit the Box Moor Trust. The focus of this visit is on 'Plants', which the children have been learning about in their science lessons. During the visit the children will participate in identifying, labelling and collecting a variety of plants, the uses of plants and a meadow sweep. They will also participate in shelter building.

Children only need to wear their school sweatshirt/ t-shirt but must have suitable trousers and footwear for a day spent outside (e.g. trainers and jogging bottoms) and in case of wet weather a waterproof. If it is a hot day, please ensure your child has a sunhat and **has sunscreen applied** before they arrive at school.

Everyone will need a packed lunch **and** water bottle. (No glass bottles, fizzy drinks, chocolate, nuts or sweets please). **Please ensure that you DO NOT pack any of the following foods: EGGS, SESAME, NUTS, HUMMUS, AVACADO, PEPPER.**

Coaches cannot access this site, however we have organised one minibus to transport 14 children and some staff to and from the venue. Therefore, we are kindly asking if some parents would be able to organise car shares between themselves to drop off and pick up the rest of the children. If anyone is able to assist with this please do email Miss Kay, as soon as possible. Many thanks.

Children will need to arrive promptly at the venue for 9.30am and picked up at 2.30pm.

Payment and consent should be made via your Arbor app. If you hold a Dacorum discount card or if you are eligible for Pupil Premium then the voluntary contribution is reduced to **£2.18**.
