Hot weather

As you will already appreciate there is an red weather warning for this week. We are following the guidance provided to us by the Local Authority and from the government.

These adaptations have been put in place:

- Regular water breaks
- No vigorous physical activity will be taking place during the school day or at break/lunch time
- Children to use the shade when outside
- Blinds down in all classrooms and windows open in morning. If possible, to close windows if hotter outside than inside in the afternoon, whilst considering the need to maintain adequate ventilation
- Ensure children are wearing just one layer. Remove jumpers and cardigans.

- Children can wear sandals, but not crocs or flip flops

A big thank you to those of you who have purchased fans for the school. This is very much appreciated.

If children want to bring in their own named small fans they can.

Please can I ask parents to ensure that their child/ren have:

- a named sun hat
- a named water bottle
- sunscreen already applied. Children can bring a labelled sun screen bottle to school, but the child will need to administer it themselves.
