I thought it might be useful to confirm events for our Year 6.

Transition day – Thursday 9 July

We co-ordinate our transition day, with all the other secondary schools in Hertfordshire. The majority of our Year 6 children will be visiting their secondary school. If your child's transition day is NOT on Thursday 9 July, your child will be given an authorised absence if you chose to keep them at home. If they come to school they will be with a member of staff in the morning, supporting with them with a variety of tasks and then supporting a class in the afternoon. Please do let us know if you are planning for your child to be in school on 9 July.

Year 6 Show – Tuesday 21 July at 7pm

Children need to be at Greenway for 6.30pm with their water bottle. If they come to the Year 6 classroom doors the Year 6 team will be there to meet them. Parents/family if you can queue outside the main entrance and we can let you in when Year 6 are ready! The show will start at 7pm. Refreshments will be offered after the performance.

Please could we kindly ask that you have a maximum of 4 seats for the production and bare in mind that the Year 6 will present their show to the rest of school (Reception-Year 5) on Monday 20 July. I know they have been working really hard and they are all looking forward to presenting to you.

Year 6 Graduation – Wednesday 22 July at 2pm

This will take place at 2pm. This should last for about 45mins. After the Year 6 Graduation, from approximately 3-4.30pm, you are invited to bring a picnic to share with your family on the large field. This gives the Year 6 children an opportunity to look at their Year book and open their gifts. Siblings usually join the picnic when they have finished school. Please bring chairs and picnic blankets if you wish to. An ice cream van will also be on-site for Year 6 children and their families only. The GSA are kindly serving Pimms!
